

MEASURING GUIDELINES

- 1. Always use a metal tape.
- 2. Measure the glass area inside the mullions (frame)
- 3. Record measurements in inches (do not use feet, yards, centimeters or meters)
- 4. Record measurements width first, height second (W x H) Be careful not to transpose measurements.
- 5. Take all your measurements to the nearest 1/8 inch (.125).
- 6. Measure the width of EVERY window in 3 different places (top, middle and bottom). Use the widest measurement.
- 7. Measure the height of EVERY window using the same steps as #6.
- 8. Measure all windows, even if they look alike.
- 9. Label your window layout from left to right and double check the measurements.
- 10. Always include the width of the mullion (frame) NOTE: Not all windows will have the same frame configuration as the above diagram.
